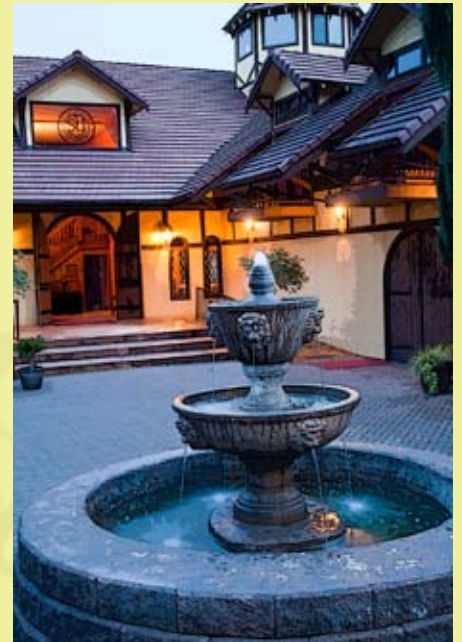

We raise our own grapes from our five estate vineyards, maintained without the use of irrigation, harsh chemicals or pesticides. We've earned both Salmon Safe and Live certifications for our sustainability.

A selection of fruit from our five sustainable vineyards are blended into our tasting room best seller. Made with Pommard & 667 clones, this wine has rich ruby color, spice and earthiness that you expect from Pinot Noir and velvet soft lingering finish.

Because we use our own fruit that we hand pick and hand sort we are able to produce a fine wine at reasonable price year after year. We think this wine is one of the best deals around!

The extra sunshine provided some spice & pepper and our jory soils added earthiness to the complexity of the wine. Aged on French & Hungarian oak to add a velvety vanilla texture.
